We are writing to you with an update on the current situation at PSLC in light of the government announcement of Level 3+ restrictions in County Dublin. Group activities are not permitted in this phase therefore all classes are cancelled until lifting of restrictions.

Our GYM is open for individual workouts and has been extended into the Martello Room. Gym staff are working on a program for some outdoor classes.

Our POOL is open for public swims and for clubs individual training but swim lessons are cancelled.

The 5-a-side pitches will not be available for contact sport but can be booked at reception for training by local clubs operating within government guidelines.

Tennis, Padel & Badminton may continue for individual training with all competitions cancelled.

The PSLC BAR is now closed and the BISTRO will continue to serve takeaway tea & coffee.
